Terry L. Walls serves as Supreme Governor, the chief presiding officer of the Loyal Order of Moose. He was elected to this position at the 127th International Convention in Nashville in July 2015. He previously served as Supreme Jr. Governor in 2014-2015 and Supreme Prelate during 2013-2014. Terry has served on the Supreme Council, the Fraternity's corporate Board of Directors since 2003. He had previously served on the Mooseheart Board of Directors from 1999-2003 and on the Moose Legion Council from 1996-1999.

Terry joined the Moose in 1980 as a member of Tulsa, OK Lodge #862, where he holds a Life Membership. He served in numerous capacities, including Administrator from 1988 to 1996. He also holds membership at Farmers Branch, TX Lodge #2277. Terry joined Sooner Moose Legion #147 (OK) in 1983 and is a Past President.

During his tenure as Administrator, Terry's lodge earned the Lodge Merit Award every year. The lodge won a Shining Star in 1995 as "Lodge of the Year" and Terry was a finalist for "Administrator of the Year" at that same time. In addition, as Editor of the lodge publication, Terry won first place in his category in the Moose Journalism Awards.

Terry also has served the Oklahoma Moose Association as President, Vice President, Prelate, Treasurer, and District President, and has chaired the Sports, Community Service, Endowment Fund, Fraternal Giving, and Family Activities committees.

A member of the 300 Division of the Moose 25 Club, Terry received the Fellowship Degree of Honor in 1988 and the Pilgrim Degree of Merit in 1995.

Aside from the Moose, Terry is involved with the Oklahoma Council for Workplace Safety and volunteers with the Red Cross. He also enjoys golf and family gatherings.

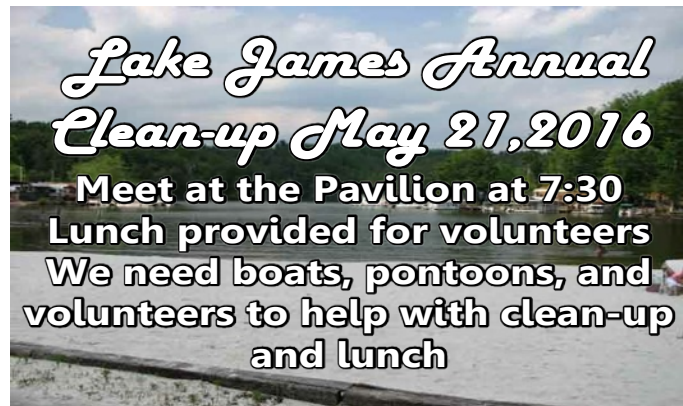

The Private Policy.... "You are either a member or a guest!"

All active members of the Order shall be admitted to the social quarters of any lodge of the Loyal Order of Moose unless his or her privileges have been suspended in accordance with the laws of the Order. Before making a purchase each day, each member should display his or her membership card. Gentlemanly/ladylike (orderly) conduct is required of all persons in the social quarters at all times.

Guest rules and guidelines: limited to 2 visits per guest over the age of 21 & only 2 guest at a time

- A qualified guest includes an active member's immediate family
- The guest must be accompanied at all times by the member who signed them in and must leave when they do
- Guest are NOT allowed to make purchases
- Members shall at all times be responsible for the conduct of their guest
- Once guests submit an application, approved for membership but prior to enrollment and becoming a member shall not make purchases.
